

NEWS FROMTHE TOWER reprints the Beckford Tower Trust Newsletter 1980–1994, published to provide information about the activities of the Beckford Tower Trust and articles relating to William Beckford (1760–1844).

Edited by Jon Millington, the Newsletter is a rich source of material for anyone interested in Beckford's Tower and the life and works of its creator and his immediate circle. Regular contributors included Eric Darton, Elizabeth Hilliard, Malcolm Jack, Didier Girard and Jon Millington.

It presents reviews of books, reports on exhibitions, and topics as diverse as Beckford and music, suppressed illustrations for *Vathek*, the Beckford family and Witham Friary, Beckford and Portugal, the railings for Beckford's tomb, and an eye-witness account of Beckford in the Revolutionary Paris of 1792. The volume includes a transcript of Beckford's early *Fragments of a Romance*. It includes much information not available anywhere else.

News from the Tower is a cornucopia of things Beckfordian. Useful as a reference tool, but also a delightful book for browsing and dipping into for those interested in William Beckford and his world.
